POLICY

Fair Play is a program introduced into minor hockey to enhance and promote SAFETY and RESPECT and a positive environment in minor hockey for all participants.

PURPOSE

Fair Play has five basic principles:

- respect the rules
- respect the opponents
- respect officials and their decisions
- have everyone participate
- maintain self control at all times

Fair Play encourages and expects all players on all teams to be as competitive as possible.

STANDARD OPERATING PROCEDURE will be the following:

FAIR PLAY (REP TEAMS):

Players/Goalies are to be played equally with only one exception. In the last 5 minutes of a "Meaningful Game", coaches may shorten the bench. A "Meaningful Game" is one that could get you in the crossovers of a tournament thereby getting all players one or two more games. This may include any games leading to and including Provincial playdown games. The foregoing also applies to Goalies.

FAIR PLAY (HOUSE LEAGUE/NOVICE/Initiation):

Plain and Simple - Equal Ice time for everyone- EVERY GAME!

Positives of Fair Play:

- Increased safety, respect and fun for all
- Increased positive team unity
- More appropriate spectator behavior
- Decreased "Win at all Cost" attitude
